Below, I have included information concerning the Research Carousel and the Poster dimensions.

Each year, IAAOC sponsors a research carousel highlighting current professional issues, best practices and innovative research in the field of addictions and offender (forensic) counseling settings. The carousel is a presentation at the American Counseling Association's annual conference in the format of poster presentations.

The Research Carousel is poster presentations. The carousel will consist of IAAOC's own poster sessions that will last 90 minutes. Each presenter will have their own poster presentation and people will stop by the poster session, just as with the typical conference poster presentations. The carousel gives us an opportunity to host/sponsor our own posters and have our own location where people can come learn about addiction and/or offender topics.

Here is the information I have gathered concerning the size of the poster and also some additional information. Please let me know if you have any questions. I also have included an example of an academic poster.

Posters should be professional with printed text. Recommended size for each poster is 48"x 36". You will be provided with an 8' X 4' bulletin board and a supply of thumb tacks/push pins. No audiovisual equipment will be provided. You are responsible for setting up your poster session and removing it immediately following your presentation. Your Poster Session must have a professional appearance. Please remember to use large enough print, graphs, charts or designs to be easily viewed from a distance of not less than 8-10 feet. We suggest using bullet or outline format. All type should be a minimum of 24-font size (1/4 inch). Please refer to the IAAOC poster guidelines for more information.
