Item	Description	Costs
ACSM Registration	All attendees must register. As an accepted student presenter, I must register under <i>in-person student</i> .	\$359.00 <i>Fixed price</i>
Transportation AU<>ATL	Using AU recommended transportation system, Groome, I can book the trip in advance to reach ATL airport in Atlanta.	\$102 (or 2x 51.0 for each way cost). <i>Fixed price</i>
Flight Auburn <> Denver	Search routinely, and the price is updated as of March 27 th . No checked bag. Economy/cheapest choice. No insurance. Price does not include tax.	\$416.00 <i>Variable price per day, and rising rapidly</i>
Stay/lodging	The conference offers a stay at their convention center. Several options are sold out, and others are selling out quickly. I have offered/asked colleagues to share rooms if possible, and I am not opposed in sharing room with any of my colleagues. I have no accessibility needs or special requests for the room. The cheapest room option was selected (and sleeps 2). Price includes tax.	\$760.00 <i>Variable price per room/hotel availability.</i>
Transportation DEN<>Convention Center	Intend to use shuttle between airport and the stay/hotel or convention center. All other transportation, if any, is personal cost and thus not included in the budget. There is no info on the website on the transportation between airport and the hotel.	Unknown <i>Variable price based on the transportation method (free shuttle vs Uber/Lyft)</i>
Meal	Only the meals associated with attending the conference, i.e., breakfast and lunch, are included in the budget. The hotel may provide complementary breakfast which I intend to use. That would leave lunch as the only meal included in the budget. I have no dietary restrictions or special needs. Cost included is the average meal costs in Denver (from their local government website). I intend to use the most economical meal types/options.	\$48.00 <i>Variable price based on tax information and availability of options.</i>
