You have agreed to the following statements:

I understand that each person is permitted to submit and be FIRST (Presenting) author on one scientific and one clinical case abstract for the Annual Meeting (which includes the World Congress on the Basic Science of Muscle Hypertrophy and Atrophy) and one Scientific Abstract for the World Congress on Exercise is Medicine, but may co-author as many other abstracts as desired. I understand that if I submit as FIRST author on more than one abstract per meeting, only one abstract will be accepted; all others will be rejected. If submitting an abstract for both the Annual Meeting (which includes the World Congress on the Basic Science of Muscle Hypertrophy and Atrophy) and World Congress on Exercise is Medicine, each submission must be two different abstracts/studies.

As the first author, I understand that I will be the presenting author on this abstract.

As the presenting author, I agree to pay all costs associated with attendance at the meeting, including registration.

I affirm that the research represented in this abstract has not been published as an abstract, or as a full paper in a scientific, medical, or professional publication at the time of submission. Abstract data may not be presented prior to the meeting. I understand that the ONLY exception to this policy concerns abstracts presented at an **ACSM** Regional Chapter meeting.

I understand that the Board of Trustees has a long-standing policy stating that speakers who fail to provide notice of a reason acceptable to the Program Committee for not delivering an accepted abstract may impact my ability to present at future **ACSM** meetings.

I understand that, per Program Committee policy, only the first author may withdraw the abstract.

I affirm that all authors included here have approved the submitted abstract.

I understand that human studies must comply with the **ACSM** statement regarding the use of human subjects and informed consent. (MSSE®, Vol. 30, No. 7, July 1998, "Policy Statement Regarding the Use of Human Subjects and Informed Consent.")
