Dear Hyun Sung Jang,

The paper you submitted "Manifesting Environmental Poverty: K-12 Achievement in Alabama" is scheduled to be presented in the Roundtable Session "Poverty: Studying the Multifaceted Nature of Poverty in Schools" at the 2022 AERA Annual Meeting. Your co-authors are copied on this email for awareness.

The AERA Annual Meeting Online Portal is now open for authors of individual paper submissions accepted for paper, roundtable, and poster sessions to upload a copy of the final paper to be presented at the 2022 AERA Annual Meeting. All papers must be uploaded no later than March 28, 2022. Session chairs and discussants (if applicable) will review the uploaded papers through the online portal in order to prepare for the session.

If you haven't already, now is the time to [register and reserve a hotel room](#). All presenting authors of accepted papers and participants in all accepted sessions, whether place-based or virtual, are expected to register for the Annual Meeting and be present at the scheduled sessions.

INDIVIDUAL PAPER SUBMISSION UPLOAD REQUIREMENTS:

All presenters of individual papers accepted for presentation in a paper, poster, or roundtable format may upload a final paper into the online portal. The paper should include any additional research findings and conclusions from the time of submission. The paper should address the elements required for submission in greater detail and should expand upon the initial 2,000 word paper. There is no word limit for the final paper. If you do not upload a final paper, the initial paper uploaded during the submission process will constitute the final paper.

Poster presenters need to upload a final paper only if they would like to be part of the repository and provide a revised version of their paper. Otherwise a final paper upload is not required since there is no chair or discussant that will need to review the paper to prepare for the session.

ONLINE PAPER REPOSITORY:

All authors may elect to have their papers, presentations, or commentary papers included in the [AERA Online Paper Repository](#). Many elected to do so at the time of submission, but the option remains available at the time of uploading. The repository is intended to provide broad dissemination of research presentations made at Annual Meetings.

UPLOAD AND ONLINE PAPER REPOSITORY INSTRUCTIONS:

The deadline to upload papers is March 28, 2022.

1. Type www.aera.net into your web-browser. Click on 'Login' at the top of the screen and log in with your username and password. Select 'My AERA' at the top of the screen and scroll down to '2022 AERA Annual Meeting' and click on '2022 AERA Annual Meeting Online Portal – Upload Final Paper'.
2. Underneath the General Menu, click on 'Upload Final Paper'.
3. If you were the submitter, scroll down on the page to the 'Submissions' tab. Click the 'upload' link in the Action column located to the right of the title for the paper you wish to upload. If you were not the submitter, scroll down on the page to the 'Participations' tab. Click the 'upload' link in the Action column located to the right of the title for the paper you wish to upload.
4. You will see an Upload Final Draft Screen. At the top of the page, click either 'yes' or 'no' to participate in the online paper repository.
5. Upload your paper and click the 'Accept and Continue' button at the bottom right of the screen.
6. If you need to upload a further revised paper before the March 28 deadline, just follow the instructions above. You cannot edit the paper once it has been uploaded. Uploading a new paper will remove the old paper.
