Dear Jessica Weise,

We are pleased to inform you that your paper, "'No time! There's never any time!': Conceptualizing a Critical Feminist Pandemic Pedagogy through Collaborative Autoethnography," submitted for consideration for the 2022 AERA Annual Meeting has been accepted. Congratulations on this accomplishment. AERA received more than 10,000 submissions this year. To ensure the highest quality papers presented at the Annual Meeting, your submission was reviewed by highly qualified reviewers serving on a review panel constituted by the Division J - Postsecondary Education/Division J - Section 4: Faculty, Curriculum, and Teaching. Reviewers' comments are now available on the Online Annual Meeting Program Portal (All Academic) System for your use (see note below).

The AERA meeting offers a number of session formats to feature high quality research and scholarly work. Your paper has been placed in a Paper Session session titled, "Faculty Experiences During COVID-19". Each format involves different modes of presentation. The program schedule will be available on January 17, 2022.

As AERA plans for the 2022 Annual Meeting, we are continuing to monitor the impact of COVID-19. Our goal is to hold the safest meeting possible. As announced in [Highlights](#) on October 29, AERA is now planning the 2022 conference as a blended meeting, with a place-based component in San Diego and with a virtual component.

On November 10, 2021, you will receive an email that will provide you and everyone in your session with an opportunity to decide by December 3, 2021, whether, as a group, you prefer your session to be place-based in San Diego or virtual (as best that you can determine based on current COVID-19 conditions and the resumption of place-based events).

The November 10 group email will provide a user-friendly detailed process to all presenting participants. Via that group email or whatever way is most comfortable for your group to confer, we will be requesting a group decision, with ultimately the lead organizer/chair recording the group's preferred decision to present in San Diego or virtually. Using the All Academic system, the chair will

then record that decision.

You will have a little over three weeks to decide as a group. In selecting this approach, AERA Council appreciates that group decisions are not always the easiest to reach. Nonetheless, it gives voice to your preferences and allows you to participate in co-creating the meeting and deciding on what overall works best.

If health and safety conditions deteriorate in the months ahead, sessions that elect to be place-based by December 3, 2021, will still have an additional opportunity to move to virtual later in the winter if necessary. Nevertheless, if your group knows now that virtual is the best or only choice for 2022, we want to plan accordingly rather than have place-based sessions cancel.

We also want to emphasize that each paper must have one or more presenting authors and that all presenting authors must register for the Annual Meeting no later than February 12, 2022. Individuals who are not listed as presenting authors cannot present at the Annual Meeting. If a presenting author does not register for the meeting by February 15, 2022, their name will be removed as a presenting author. If no presenting author has registered by February 15, 2022, the paper will be removed from the program. The final deadline for program changes is March 7, 2022. This includes changes to paper titles, session titles, and authors, as well as Session Chairs and Discussants.

Copies of all 2022 Annual Meeting program related e-mail correspondence sent from the All Academic System, including this email, are available online in your personal "Message Center." This link is available in the Submitter menu of the All Academic System once you have signed in.

Registration and housing for the 2022 Annual Meeting will open in December 2021. Since all presenters must register for the meeting, please register early to take advantage of the Early Bird rates. The 2022 AERA Annual Meeting will take place Thursday, April 21-Tuesday, April 26, 2022.
