This involves face-to-face/in-person working session starting 1pm on Sunday November 5th Tuesday November 7th, immediately prior to the ISSOTL23 conference in Utrecht, The Netherlands (November 8th -11th, 2023). Before and after the conference, the groups will work together online to ultimately produce a public SoTL artifact no later than October 2024.
- Remote collaborative work in the months both before and after this hands-on workshop in Utrecht (April 2023 through October 2024)
- Please note costs are approximate at the moment in USD and may be subject to slight changes:
 - Payment of ICWG registration by the end of June (in 2022 this was \$375 for nonstudents, and \$200 for students). ICWG registration will include dinner on Sunday, snacks and lunches on Monday and Tuesday, along with some other social activities.
 - Payment of registration for ISSOTL (in 2022 Early Bird Regular Member Registration cost ~\$500, and included snacks during breaks, 2 lunches, and a poster reception with snacks and one drink.

In the past, there have been a handful of small ICWG travel subsidies (max \$300) available based on need. We are hoping that something similar will be available this year. We will share a link with you once we know if it's available. At present, we are also in discussions with the ISSOTL board to consider an Emerging Scholars Fund that could be used to waiver ISSOTL

registration fees. We will update you further once we have confirmation that this fund is available for the ICWG and Conference. However, if you have an extenuating circumstance that prevents you from attending the full ISSOTL conference following the ICWG meeting, please let us know.

We are excited about the communities and SoTL academic articles that will be developed in this coming year, and we look forward to working with you along the way.
