We are pleased to inform you that your paper, "Manifesting Environmental Poverty: K-12 Achievement in Alabama," submitted for consideration for the 2022 AERA Annual Meeting has been accepted. Congratulations on this accomplishment. AERA received more than 10,000 submissions this year. To ensure the highest quality papers presented at the Annual Meeting, your submission was reviewed by highly qualified reviewers serving on a review panel constituted by the Division L - Educational Policies and Politics/Division L - Section 7: Social Context and Structural Inequalities. Reviewers' comments are now available on the Online Annual Meeting Program Portal (All Academic) System for your use (see note below).

The AERA meeting offers a number of session formats to feature high quality research and scholarly work. Your paper has been placed in a Roundtable Session session titled, "Poverty: Studying the multifaceted nature of poverty in schools".

As AERA plans for the 2022 Annual Meeting, we are continuing to monitor the impact of COVID-19. Our goal is to hold the safest meeting possible. As announced in [Highlights](#) on October 29, AERA is now planning the 2022 conference as a blended meeting, with a placed-based component in San Diego and with a virtual component.

All papers accepted for roundtable or poster sessions will be held in the virtual component of the meeting. AERA issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) in mid-October and will be selecting a platform that offers a Zoom option by the end of December. The program schedule will be available on January 17, 2022.

Further details regarding virtual roundtable sessions and the preparation of posters will be provided in December 2021.

We also want to emphasize that each paper must have one or more presenting authors and that all presenting authors must register for the Annual Meeting no later than February 12, 2022. Individuals who are not listed as presenting authors cannot present at the Annual Meeting. If a presenting author does not register for the meeting by February 15, 2022, their name will be removed as a presenting author. If no presenting author has registered by February 15, 2022, the paper will be removed from the program. The final deadline for program changes is March 7, 2022. This includes changes to paper titles, session titles, and authors, as well as Session Chairs and Discussants.

Copies of all 2022 Annual Meeting program related e-mail correspondence sent from the All Academic System, including this email, are available online in your personal "Message Center." This link is available in the Submitter menu of the All Academic System once you have signed in.

Whether your presentation(s) are in the place-based or virtual components of the Annual Meeting, we encourage you to attend the place-based meetings where we plan to have opportunities for informal networking and authors-meet-authors exchange. All attendees in San Diego will also have full access to the virtual component of the meeting irrespective of whether they are virtual presenters.

Registration and housing for the 2022 Annual Meeting will open in December 2021. Since all presenters must register for the meeting, please register early to take advantage of the Early Bird rates. The 2022 AERA Annual Meeting will take place Thursday, April 21-Tuesday, April 26, 2022.
