ACSM is expecting this abstract/clinical case to be presented in-person in Salt Lake City. However, if an extenuating circumstance arises that prohibits you from presenting your abstract,

please immediately inform the ACSM Education Department via email at education@acsm.org. The Board of Trustees has a long-standing policy stating that speakers who fail to provide notice of a reason acceptable to the Program Committee for not delivering an accepted paper will be prohibited from presenting at future annual meetings. Also, be advised that per Program Committee policy, only the first author may withdraw the abstract.

If a co-author is available to present in the absence of a first author, you MUST inform the [ACSM Education Department](#) so this can be noted appropriately, and the first author is not considered a no-show. Not registering for the meeting does not imply you are not planning to present.
