Title	<b>Ethical Considerations in Counseling Persons with Disabilities</b>
Description	<p>Ethics in counseling is a fundamental consideration for professionals whose responsibility it is to up of clients as well as the public and professional communities in which they operate. Ethical issues receive attention in our training and work as counselors, but, as the proposed education session will demonstrate, is a magnified significance when our work impacts a person with a disability. Presenters will provide about differences in various codes that guide the counseling profession, special considerations when working with a client with a disability and how counselor educators, specifically, can incorporate this knowledge into training and preparation of counseling students. The proposed education session will have three primary goals: 1) Enhanced knowledge; 2) Related knowledge and experiences, and 3) Applied knowledge. The essence of the proposed education session is to demonstrate the application of common ethical principles in areas that may be considered outside of one's expertise. The education session format is an ideal delivery method for disseminating the information, engaging participants and facilitating the application of what is learned. Other formats could allow for a more condensed, but equally rich experience. In terms of conference presentation, the session focuses on enhancing participants' understanding of ethics and forging new ideas into practice.</p>
