If you are delivering work in our "PVDS" format, please expect communication from Dr. Bridget Turner Kelly and Dr. Wilson Okello as the conference approaches. Dr. Turner Kelly and Dr. Okello are organizing logistics for these sessions and will be working with each presenter to ensure a successful performance/presentation/delivery.

Roundtable and Poster Sessions
