#### What does the Registration Fee Include?

<u>Professional, Non-Member, and Student Registration Fee:</u> The registration fee provides each attendee with the conference program and delegate materials, capstone event, and a professional development tour (April 7). The fee also includes refreshment breaks as per the agenda, as well as the Monday Poster Reception, Lunch on Tuesday and Wednesday, Awards Reception on Wednesday evening, and continental breakfast and tea/coffee on Thursday morning. The student fee also includes light dinner and transportation for the student social.

**Guest Fee:** The guest fee includes access to all conference meal functions, capstone event, and a professional development tour. Suggested guest activities during the conference are not included and payment should be arranged through the concierge. Guests must accompany a sponsoring AIAEE member to qualify for the guest rate. No individual listed as a co-author on any abstract presentation, poster presentation, professional development workshop, or Ignite session may register as a guest.

<u>Virtual Registration Fee:</u> The virtual fee includes access to the app with all session presentations (professional development, keynote speakers, poster and research presentations), a playlist with all the live video feeds on UTube, access to voting and networking online, and presentation abstracts in the proceedings.

Refund Policy: Written notice of cancellation must be received by Friday, March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022. A processing fee of 50% will be deducted from the total cancellation amount.
