Next Steps:

In order for you to present at the conference and be included in the conference program and proceedings, we do have a few next steps and upcoming dates. These dates are also [listed on the conference site](#) as well.

1. Complete and sign the presenter form and also upload your photo for our website at your earliest possible convenience, using [this personalized link](#), by **February 15, 2022** at the latest.
2. Register for the conference under the [Registration tab](#) on the conference website at your earliest convenience. Please note that everyone who will attend or present must pay a registration fee; one presenter per session may register at the lower "speaker" rate.
3. Submit your paper, if you would like to publish a paper in the conference proceedings (papers are optional for presenters), according to the guidelines below. The deadline is **March 15, 2022**. All papers must be typed directly into the conference template -- please download and use either the [PC version](#) or the [Mac version](#), whichever you prefer. Papers will then undergo blind review and you may be asked to make revisions in order for your paper to be accepted. You are already accepted as a presenter. Papers may be either "Full papers" (10-12 pages in length) or "Short papers" (6-8 pages), whichever you prefer. The conference proceedings will be published as a book/ebook by Springer. The books in this series are planned to be indexed by SCOPUS, DBLP, EI Compendex, INSPEC, WTI Frankfurt eG, zbMATH, Japanese Science and Technology Agency (JST), and SCImago, and submitted for consideration in Web of Science. Submit your initial paper by uploading it at your [personalized submission link](#).
4. Submit a copy of your slides for inclusion in the conference proceedings, if you would like to do so. We will reach out with details as it gets closer; the approximate date will be **June 1, 2022**. We will also arrange a time for a test session with our conference platform, whether you will be presenting online or in person, as it gets closer to the conference.

Once again, we are pleased to inform you that your proposal has been accepted, and we hope to see you in June!
