# 05-06 Nursery Survey KEY RESULTS

- 1. Regional bareroot conifer production dropped by around 10%.
- 2. There were declines in loblolly, slash and longleaf production.
- 3. Regional bareroot hardwood production saw a decline of around 30%.
- 4. Regional bareroot conifer production by ownership category remains unchanged.



# 05-06 Nursery Survey KEY RESULTS

- 5. Regional bareroot hardwood production appears to have shifted away from the "private" category.
- 6. There has been a change in state production rankings.
- 7. Coop membership continues to dominate bareroot production in the region, but only 33% of container production.
