GEAR UP Achieve, an initiative led by Auburn University, is dedicated to expanding access to higher education and improving academic outcomes for low-income and first-generation students. The program serves approximately 6,500 students across seven regions in Alabama, equipping them with the knowledge, resources, and support needed to successfully enroll in and complete postsecondary education (PSE). Through targeted services, strategic partnerships, and sustained academic engagement, GEAR UP Achieve seeks to accomplish the following core goals:

- 1. Provide access to rigorous coursework that prepares students for PSE.
- 2. Assist students in completing critical steps for PSE.
- 3. Implement an advising program to support PSE aspirations.
- 4. Increase funding awareness and help navigate financial aid.

- 5. Implementation plan
- 6. Proposed Budget (not to exceed \$75,000)
- 7. Documentation of commitment to match funding
- 8. References from previous clients

- Cost-effectiveness and scalability of the proposal
- Demonstrated ability to engage target populations
- Clarity and feasibility of the implementation plan
