Global Bridge Program
Summer Academic Program with Conditional Admission
May 17 – August 1, 2012

Program Features

- Two academic courses for 6 credits toward an undergraduate degree program
- Three English language courses (oral communication, written communication, reading comprehension) for 9 credits toward an undergraduate degree program
- Simplified admissions application and fast-track processing
- On-campus housing with ample dining options
- University town experience with many weekend activities including excursions to popular local destinations
- Students who earn an A/B in each academic course are admissible to the Fall 2012 undergraduate degree programs without a TOEFL or IELTS score
- Other students will take an Institutional TOEFL at the end of the program for admission to Auburn University, Auburn University-Montgomery or other local colleges or universities

Requirements:

- High school transcript with a minimum grade point average of 2.5 out of 4.0
- Strong language skills and a demonstrated desire to succeed at a top American University (TOEFL score of 500 pBT/61 iBT or an IELTS of 6)

Costs:

- Application fee: \$60
- Tuition and fees (15 academic credits): \$11,835
- Medical insurance: \$385
- Campus housing: approximately \$2,000

About Auburn University:

Auburn University was established in 1856. Auburn's approximately 25,000 students choose from more than 140 degree options in 12 schools and colleges at the undergraduate, graduate and professional levels.
