**Byoung Chul Park**, an outstanding Korean calligrapher, will show the participants the art of calligraphy with special brushes on Korean paper, Hanji. The demonstration presents various facets of Korean calligraphy, which constitutes an intricate convergence of characters and design forms. Using a variety of writing techniques, the artist transcribes Korean poems and literature into flowing strokes of "grass hand," the bold, angular characters known as "running hand," and several other styles. The participants will unfold their senses in the movement of the brush and patterns of ink, a delicate dance between the lines and spaces. With these living forms of art, they can explore the profound range of human expression in Korean alphabet and design.
