To thy name we'll sing thy praise From hearts that love so true And pledge to thee our loyalty The ages through.


We hail thee, Auburn, and we vow To work for thy just fame, And hold in memory as we do now Thy cherished name.

# AUBURN UNIVERSITY BOARD OF TRUSTEES COMMENCEMENT SPEAKERS



#### **BOB DUMAS**

Robert W. Dumas is the retired President and CEO of AuburnBank and Auburn National Bancorporation, Inc., where he continues to serve as Chairman of the Board of Directors. Dumas was appointed to the Board of Trustees by Governor Robert Bentley and confirmed by the Alabama Senate on April 10, 2012, to represent the 3rd District. Dumas earned a bachelor's degree in business administration with a major in finance from Auburn in 1976. His first term expired on April 9, 2022, and he was reappointed to a second term by Governor Kay Ivey and confirmed by the Alabama Senate on March 22, 2023. His second term will expire on March 21, 2030.

Dumas is actively involved in many civic and charitable organizations within the community (Lee County). Dumas previously served on the Auburn University College of Business Advisory Council, and he previously served as a Director of the Alabama Bankers Association and as Chairman of the association. He is a former Director of the Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta. He continues to serve as a Director on the Board of the East Alabama Medical Center and as a Director on the Board of the Auburn Research Technology Foundation. Dumas is a lifetime member of the Auburn Alumni Association and is married to the former Martha Butz, who holds two degrees from Auburn University. Their two children are graduates of Auburn University and reside in Auburn. Dumas and his wife have seven grandchildren.



#### **JAMES SANFORD**

James (Jimmy) Hopson Sanford is the former chairman of the Birmingham Branch of the Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta, the National Cotton Council of America in Memphis, and a former board director of Alabama Power Company. As a student, Sanford was Commander of Sigma Nu Fraternity and graduated from Auburn University in 1968 with a bachelor's degree in business administration and in 1971 with a master of science in economics with his thesis accepted by the Ralph Brown Draughon Library. In 2021, the Edward Via College of Osteopathic Medicine (VCOM) awarded him the Doctor of Humanities and Letters.

Jimmy serves the following organizations: Chairperson of HOME Place Farms, Choice Cotton, Alabama Cotton Commission, EDPA Foundation and Auburn Technology and Research Foundation; President of Autauga Quality Cotton Association and Legends Properties; Vice Chairperson of Judson College and the Judson Foundation; and Director of VCOM. Also as a board director, he serves on a number of not for profit civic and industry organizations.

He was appointed to the Board of Trustees by Governor Robert Bentley and confirmed by the Alabama Senate on March 15, 2012, to represent the 4th District. His first term expired on March 14,2019, and he was reappointed to a second term by Governor Kay Ivey and confirmed by the Alabama Senate on February 3, 2021. His second term will expire on February 2, 2028.

He is married to Dorothy (Dot) Hardage Sanford. They have three Auburn graduated children and (spouses): Susan Jones, Catherine Porter (Walt Porter), Will Sanford (Anne Womack) and three grandchildren (Annabeth Jones (AU Class of 2026), Mack and Hardy Sanford.



#### **PROVOST VINI NATHAN**

Dr. Vini Nathan began serving as Auburn University's provost and senior vice president for academic affairs in May 2023 after serving for a year as interim provost. Previously, Nathan was the dean and McWhorter Chair of the College of Architecture, Design and Construction from 2011-2022. She is also a tenured professor of Architecture and Interior Architecture and is a Senior Fellow of the Design Futures Council.

As provost, Nathan is the university's chief academic officer and oversees the university's academic and outreach missions. Nathan works with faculty, staff, students, alumni and other stakeholders to ensure the university maintains the highest possible outreach and teaching and learning programs. In carrying out these responsibilities, she works directly with the deans of the 12 colleges, the university's shared governance groups, university administrators, student leaders and other Provost's Office team members. In addition, Nathan oversees faculty matters, academic issues and policies, accreditation, strategic planning, educational services and resources, faculty development and outreach and is responsible for the university's tenure and promotion process.

Prior to Auburn, Nathan held the position of dean and professor in the School of Architecture at Thomas Jefferson University. As an architect working for Walker Group/CNI in New York, Nathan collaborated with Cesar Pelli Associates to design the Kuala Lumpur City Center (Petronas Towers) in Malaysia. Nathan holds a doctor of philosophy in Architecture from the University of Michigan, a master's degree in Interior Design from Virginia Tech, and a bachelor's degree in Architecture from Anna University.

#### **NEIL LAMB, PHD**

Dr. Neil Lamb is president of the HudsonAlpha Institute for Biotechnology, a nonprofit research organization based in Huntsville, Alabama. A global leader in advancing genomics-based research, education and innovation, HudsonAlpha is widely known for pioneering breakthroughs in human health, agriculture and biotechnology through collaborative science and real-world application.

Appointed as the Institute's second president in July 2022, Dr. Lamb previously led its Educational Outreach division for 16 years, where he spearheaded nationally recognized programs that reach over one million learners annually and have transformed science education across the country.

Dr. Lamb earned his doctoral degree in genetics and molecular biology from Emory University, where he studied trisomy 21, the genetic basis of Down syndrome. After a brief period in family programming and communications at a large Atlanta-area church, he returned to Emory as a faculty member in the Department of Human Genetics, serving as Director of Education and Director of the Center for Medical Genomics.

His work in science education has earned national acclaim, including the 2018 Faraday Science Communicator Award from the National Science Teaching Association and the 2021 Arno Motulsky–Barton Childs Award for Excellence in Human Genetics Education from the American Society of Human Genetics.

Dr. Lamb holds a B.S. in molecular biology from Auburn University ('92) and a Ph.D. from Emory University ('97). He and his wife, Cynthia ('92) live in Madison, Alabama, and are the proud parents of Auburn graduates Preston ('20), Olivia ('21), and Emma Grace, who will graduate in spring 2026.





#### **ACADEMIC REGALIA**



Academic regalia worn during graduation is based on attire from the 12th and 13th centuries when universities were being established. Academic dress and accourrements have been used in higher education in the United States since colonial times. In 1895, an intercollegiate commission adopted a standardized code for the use of academic gowns, hoods, and caps, which included regulation of style and materials. Colors were prescribed to represent different fields of learning. Since then, the majority of colleges and universities in the United States, including Auburn, have upheld the code.

#### **GOWNS**

Except for a few universities, academic gowns are all black. The bachelor's gown is the simplest of the three types. The master's gown is similar but has sleeves with an extra long extension. Representing the highest degree, the doctoral gown is fuller throughout and has pleated bell-shaped sleeves. It is trimmed with a velvet band that circles the neck and descends the front, and it has velvet bars on the sleeves.

#### **ACADEMIC HOODS**

Academic hoods have endured as the sign of a scholar, and increased symbolism through color and material. Master's hoods are edged in velvet in the color of the candidate's major field. The hood's satin lining shows Auburn's official colors. A doctoral hood is longer and larger than the master's. A doctor of philosophy's hood has dark blue velvet-bound edges and the doctor of audiology has green.

The orange and blue satin lining shows that the degree was conferred at Auburn University. The faculty who march in the academic processional show a range of colors marking their diverse fields, degrees, and institutions.

The traditional rule for academic hoods is that a candidate for a degree should not wear the hood until the degree is conferred. However, at Auburn, master's degrees are conferred en masse, therefore degree candidates wear hoods throughout the ceremony. Doctoral degree recipients are hooded by their major professor during the ceremony. These candidates do not wear the hood during the academic processional, but receive their hood when the degree is conferred.

## ACADEMIC REGALIA


#### CAPS AND TASSELS


A black mortar board is the typical headwear worn, with some faculty wearing black tams. All caps have tassels. Students earning a bachelor's degree have tassel colors representing their fields. They begin the ceremony with the tassels on the right front side; after all degrees are conferred, they are instructed to move the tassels to the left side. Faculty and candidates for master's and doctoral degrees already wear their gold tassels on the left side.

In addition to the orange stoles worn by student marshals, some graduates wear regalia signifying academic achievements or membership in organizations, primarily academic honor societies. Students graduating summa cum laude, magna cum laude, or cum laude wear yellow cords. The Honors College recognizes its graduates with silver medals. Students inducted into Phi Kappa Phi, an honor society incorporating all fields of study, may wear cords of interwoven gold and blue. Some schools and colleges have honor societies unique to their discipline, and students selected for membership wear stoles, cords or medallions representing them. Like hoods, each color and pattern is unique to the honor.





## **ACADEMIC SYMBOLS**

#### MACE


In ancient Rome, what would later be called a mace was carried at the head of processing civil authorities. By the Middle Ages, the Catholic Church similarly used a mace, which also became associated with the civil authority of monarchies. Today, the United Kingdom's House of Commons still presents a mace to mark the opening of daily sessions being open and legal. The U.S. House of Representatives adopted this practice in 1789, establishing the tradition of the Sergeant at Arms carrying the mace into the chamber to be placed near the Speaker of the House.

As an established symbol of authority, maces in the academic setting were adopted to show that a president represents the governing body of the school. Maces are used in graduation ceremonies to demonstrate that a school has the legal authority to grant degrees. Auburn's mace was created in fall 2015 from the wood of the beloved Auburn Oaks, representing the Board of Trustees' legal authority and linking to a symbol that is laden with meaning to the Auburn Family. The Auburn mace is approximately 42 inches tall and is carried by the macebearer, one of the faculty leaders from the graduation committee.



#### **GONFALONS**

Gonfalons are banners that originated in medieval Italy to identify a state or office. At Auburn commencements, each college and school is represented by a unique gonfalon, carried into the ceremony by a student marshal selected from the graduating class. The university gonfalon is carried by the faculty marshal. Additionally, smaller gonfalons stand on the edge of the floor to designate the seating area for each participating college and school.

## HISTORIC HOME OF THE AUBURN FAMILY

Chartered in 1856, Auburn University opened in 1859 and became affiliated with the Methodist Church. Throughout the years, the institution has held four official names:

East Alabama Male College (1856-72)
Agricultural and Mechanical College (1872-99)
Alabama Polytechnic Institute (1899-1960)
Auburn University (1960-present)

Auburn University at Montgomery (AUM) was established as a separately administered branch campus in 1967. The institution has developed rapidly, especially since moving to a 500-acre campus east of Montgomery in 1971. Fall 2019 enrollment at AUM was approximately 5,323.
