Admissions requirement:

Completion of the pre-professional program in Interior Design is required for students seeking admissions to the professional program. The Interior Design program is a 4-year program, even with transfer credits. Students participate in a portfolio review after completing both CADS 1000 and CADS 1100 with a "C" or higher to determine the students that matriculate into the INDS program. Admissions to the professional program is open annually in the spring semester. Pre-Interior Design students must apply in May (Day set each year.) Applicants are notified by acceptance or non-acceptance. Transfer students are strongly encouraged to contact the academic advisor (334) 844-4790 for advisement.

A professional fee of approximately \$2,000 per semester is assessed for all undergraduate students enrolled in the Interior Design and Pre-Interior Design Programs (INDS and INDX).

Students must earn a "C" or higher in all required courses in the INDS major. Students must earn a "C" or higher in all prerequisite courses in the major.

All Human Sciences students must have a laptop and students who matriculate into the INDS program will have specific technology requirements.

An internship is required. (9 credit hours)
