of faculty are satisfied with their department as a place to work.

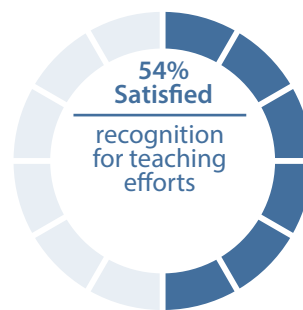
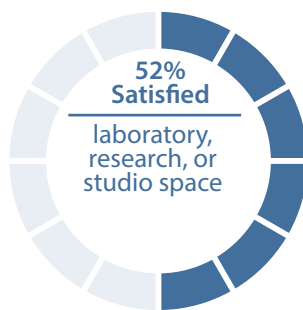
67%
