LAAB requires that programs graduate one class of students before performing its initial accreditation review. With the Fall 2021 launch of Auburn's Undergraduate Program in Landscape Architecture, the program will be eligible for the initial accreditation review in 2025-26. As a point of context, Auburn's Graduate Program in Landscape Architecture has been accredited since its inception and we are optimistic that our efforts in the Undergraduate Program will result in the same outcome. If the program is successful in its pursuits of accreditation in the 2025-2026 academic year, then accreditation will apply to all 2025 graduates as well.</p>
