State professional counselor licensure boards do not specifically license rehabilitation counselors, but the national <a href="#">Certified Rehabilitation Counselor (CRC)</a> certification, governed by Commission on Rehabilitation Counselor Certification (CRCC), may be required to practice rehabilitation counseling in some settings or agencies. This program meets all educational and testing requirements needed to obtain national CRC certification. To obtain a state professional counselor license, some states require additional educational requirements beyond the curriculum provided at Auburn.
