

There will be no change in CIP Codes associated with the renaming requests. If approved by the Offices of the Provost and the President, the proposed program changes would be forwarded to Auburn University's Board of Trustees for review and approval.

Review and Consultation: The proposed changes will bring the program names into alignment with current standards of relevant accrediting bodies and constituencies and better reflect the nature of the programs. The proposals were reviewed by Auburn University's Graduate Council and received approval in Fall 2014.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the program changes be approved, and forwarded to Auburn University's Board of Trustees for review and approval.
