Subject: Art History Curriculum changes - AP credit

Date: February 20, 2018

The approved changes to the Art History curriculum necessitate changes to how AP credit is awarded for the AP Art History Exam. The Department of Art & Art History proposes the following policy for articulation of AP Art History credits.

Students scoring 5 on the AP Art History Exam will be assigned 3 hours of Auburn University credit. These hours will articulate as ARTS 2100.

Students scoring 4 on the AP Art History Exam will be given 3 hours of Auburn University credit. These hours will articulate as ARTS 2100.

No credit will be awarded for a score of 3 on the AP Art History Exam.
