The Auburn Trustee Selection Committee, in our effort to ensure a fully open, inclusive and transparent process, is reopening the nomination period for vacancies on the Auburn Board. We encourage all interested individuals to apply. For those who applied previously, please let us know if you still wish to be considered by providing your information at the web address listed below.

Please note that all nomination information should be submitted electronically to the following link: www.auburn.edu/trusteenominees2011. Your nomination letter, resume and any letters of support should be submitted by 4:45 p.m. on Friday, June 24, 2011.

The Auburn Board currently has nine vacancies: Districts 1, 2, 3-Lee County, 3, 4, 6, 7, 9 and one at-large position. Please see the adjoining map to determine in which district you reside.

As in the past, members of the Committee are looking for leaders who are forward-looking, service-oriented and dedicated to furthering Auburn's instruction, research and extension missions. After nominations are received, the Committee plans to meet in August to select no more than three nominees for each available position for interviews. Interviews will be conducted by a majority of the Committee and will conclude no later than September 30th. The Committee consists of two members from the Board of Trustees, two members from the Auburn Alumni Association's Board of Directors, and me as President of the Auburn Board or my designee. After these interviews, the Committee will appoint individuals to the open seats and forward their names to the State Senate for confirmation.

As described in the Alabama Constitution, the following are the only requirements to serve on the Auburn Board:

- *Must be a resident of the continental United States
- *Must be less than 70 years of age when appointed
- *Cannot be an employee of Auburn University
- *Cannot be a member of the Selection Committee


