The Runway 18/36 Rehab Project at the Auburn University Regional Airport (AUO) will begin April 5, 2021 at 7:00 A.M. CDT, NAVAIDS RWY 18/36 **OTS** April 1, 2021. The initial three (3) phases of the project are expected to last a TOTAL of 8 consecutive weeks. The following are closures or NOTAMs expected in the 8 weeks of the project.

April 1 - May 28: (Duration of Project):

April 5-11: Phase 1 (7 calendar days):

RWY 18/36 **CLOSED** RWY 11/29 OPEN

April 12-25: Phase 2 (14 calendar days):

RWY 18/36 OPEN - RWY 18 threshold relocated (1,272 feet)

RWY 18/36 length available (3,992 feet)

RWY 11/29 CLOSED

April 26- May 23: Phase 3 (28 calendar days):


RWY 18/36 **CLOSED** RWY 11/29 OPEN


