EFFECTIVE 04/12/2021

The Runway 18/36 Rehab Project at the Auburn University Regional Airport (AUO) began April 5, 2021. The initial three (3) phases of the project are expected to last a TOTAL of 8 consecutive weeks. Phase 1 is COMPLETE. Phase 2 is now in progress and is scheduled to be completed April 26, 2021.

The following are closures or NOTAMs expected in the 8 weeks of the project:

April 1 - May 28: (Duration of Project):

RWY 18/36 All NAVAIDS OTS

April 12-26: Phase 2 (14 calendar days):

RWY 18/36 OPEN - RWY 18 threshold relocated (1,272 feet)

RWY 18/36 North 1,272 feet CLOSED

RWY 18/36 available runway length (3,992 feet)

RWY 11/29 **CLOSED** except crossing

April 26- May 23: Phase 3 (28 calendar days):

RWY 18/36 **CLOSED** except crossing


RWY 11/29 OPEN

RUNWAY 36 IN USE


