Facilities Management Releases Mell Classroom Construction Road Closure Map

A portion of Mell Street and also the main Ralph B. Draughon Library entrance facing Mell will close after Auburn University's Fall 2015 graduation ceremony and remain closed through Summer 2017 as the university constructs the Mell Classroom Building.

The partial Mell Street closure will affect bicycle, pedestrian and vehicle traffic in the area. In an effort to help the campus community prepare for the temporary closure, Facilities Management has released a <u>construction map</u>. This map highlights the construction zone and revised traffic routes. The map is located on the Facilities Management <u>Temporary Road and Facilities Closure</u> webpage. The Mell Street project will include the construction of the Mell Classroom Building, a 69,000-square-foot facility that will include 12 new active learning classrooms and two large lecture halls, as well as renovation of 38,000 square feet of space in the Library to add 17 classrooms and more than 25 group study rooms.
