

## GRA Tuition Remission

- Motivation – provide a mechanism for the capture of tuition support for graduate students from externally funded contracts and grants in cases where this is a feasible and not a detriment to the project.
- Recommendation developed after considerable feedback from faculty (including University Senate) and administrative groups.
- Intent of the URC Sub-committee on Graduate Student Issues is for a system of voluntary participation with incentives for faculty and programs.

## GRA Tuition Remission

### *Draft Policy*

- All proposals for externally funded contracts and grants should include tuition charges for the graduate students supported by the project, *where possible based upon the circumstances and requirements of specific proposals and funding agencies.*
- The PI should provide justifications for exceptions (with approvals by department head/chair and associate dean of research).

### *Graduate Student Incentive Program*

- An amount equal to 70% of the tuition charged against a given contract or grant will be allocated to the **PI** for graduate program support.
- An amount equal to 10% will be allocated to the **department** to which the PI is affiliated for graduate program support.
- An amount equal to 10% will be allocated to the **college or school** to which the PI is affiliated for graduate program support.
- An amount equal to 10% will be allocated to the **graduate school** for the activities and initiatives for the benefit of graduate programs.
