

Central Classroom Facility

- Construct a new, central classroom facility to provide students with modern, state-of-the-art instructional space.
- Replaces Provost instructional space in Haley Center, Parker, Allison, Funchess, Upchurch, and Spidle Halls.
- Facility Size: 77,000 (Net SF)
128,000 (Gross SF)
- Estimated Cost: \$35.0 M
- Schedule:
Program and Design: 2011-2012
Construct: 2013-2014







- **2,043 vacant spaces at peak**
- **Not a number/quantity problem**
- **It is a location problem**
- **Problem areas this year > 90%**
 - **West Academic Core (Lowder, War Eagle Way)**
 - **Large Commuter Lots at Magnolia/Donahue and Arena**
 - **Large Commuter Lot at Coliseum**
