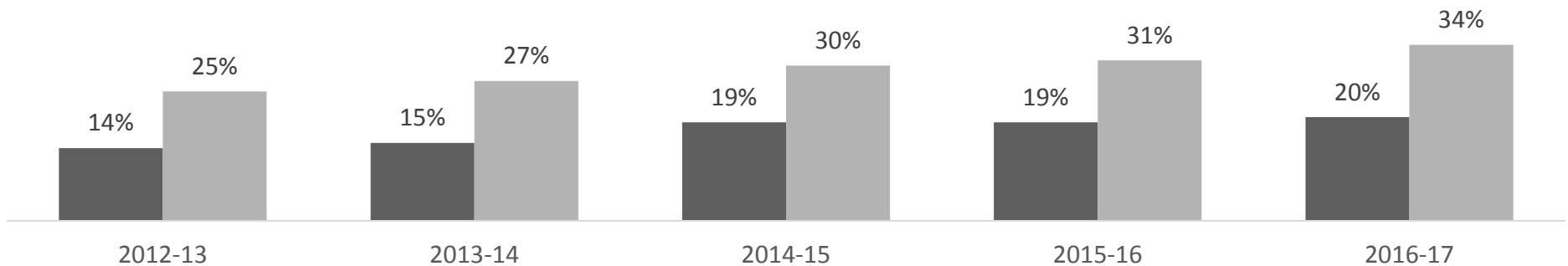

Shares of Teaching, 2012-13 through 2016-17

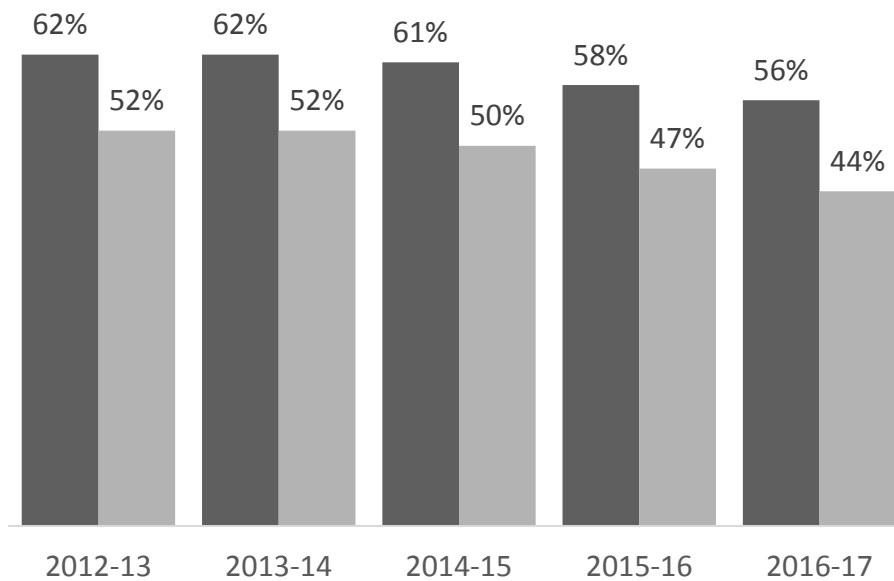

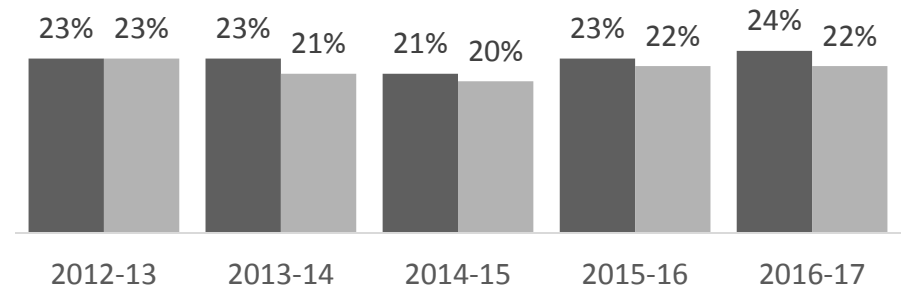

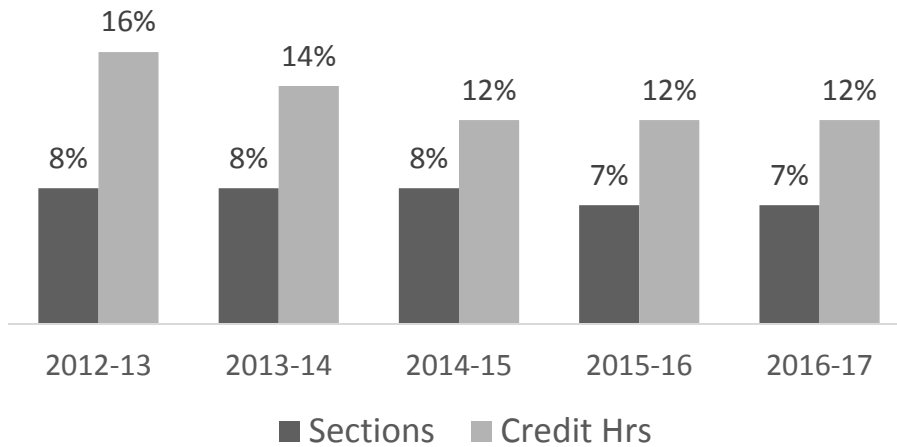
B. Tenured and Tenure-Track Faculty



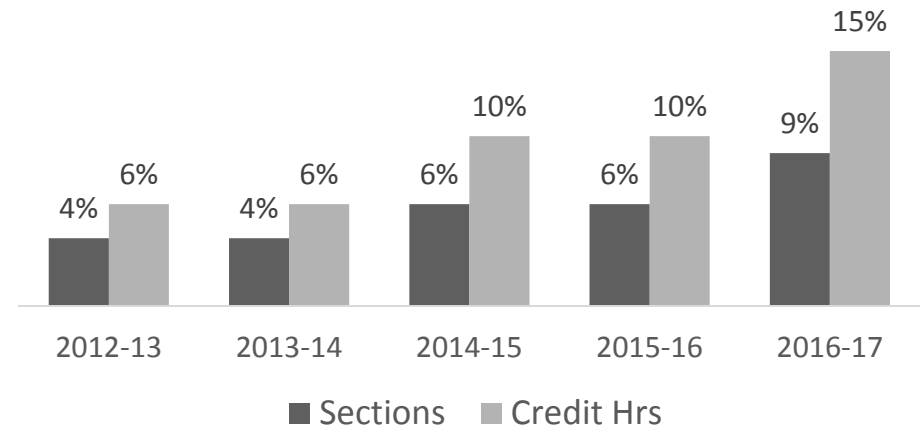

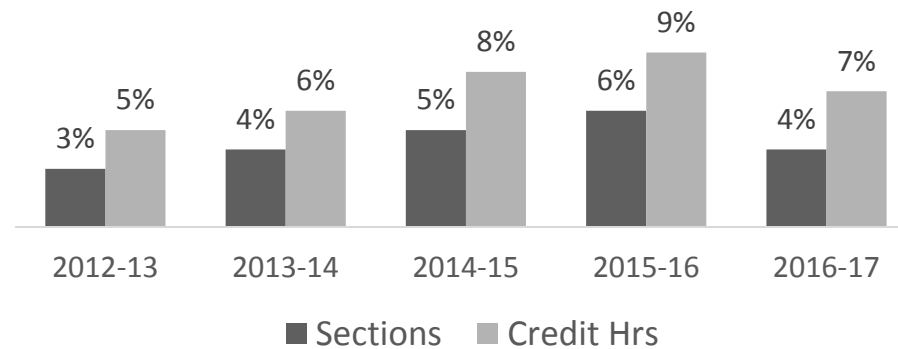
A. Teaching by Instructors

Undergraduate Teaching by Tenure-Stream Faculty at Auburn and Peer Universities

- 23 At Auburn, the share of undergraduate credit hours taught by tenured and tenure-track faculty in Fall 2013 was larger than average for research universities in 23 disciplines.
- 21 At Auburn, the share of undergraduate credit hours taught by tenured and tenure-track faculty in Fall 2013 was about average for research universities in 21 disciplines.
- 5 At Auburn, the share of undergraduate credit hours taught by tenured and tenure-track faculty in Fall 2013 was smaller than average for research universities in 5 disciplines.
