





Undergraduate Teaching by Tenure-Stream Faculty at Auburn and Peer Universities

- At Auburn, the share of undergraduate credit hours taught by tenured and tenure-track faculty in Fall 2013 was <u>larger than average</u> for research universities in 23 disciplines.
- At Auburn, the share of undergraduate credit hours taught by tenured and tenure-track faculty in Fall 2013 was <u>about average</u> for research universities in 21 disciplines.
 - At Auburn, the share of undergraduate credit hours taught by tenured and tenure-track faculty in Fall 2013 was smaller than average for research universities in 5 disciplines.
