<u>Enrollment and</u> Retention Committee: The Retention Committee shall consist of the <u>associate</u> provost <u>or designee for Undergraduate Studies</u>, the director of Academic Support, the director of Financial Aid, five faculty members, and two students. The faculty members will serve three-year rotating terms. The committee shall be responsible for continuous monitoring of the <u>enrollment and</u> retention of undergraduate students and for recommending <u>enrollment and</u> retention initiatives and working with the appropriate deans and student affairs staff to establish them.

Retention Committee: The Retention Committee shall consist of the associate provost for Undergraduate Studies, the director of Academic Support, the director of Financial Aid, five faculty members, and two students. The faculty members will serve three-year rotating terms. The committee shall be responsible for continuous monitoring of the retention of undergraduate students and for recommending retention initiatives and working with the appropriate deans and student affairs staff to establish them.
