

PURPOSE OF TITLE

 To recognize faculty who specialize in teaching and one other component of outreach, service, research, or creative work.

• Aligns and elevates teaching to a professorial title series along with Clinical, Extension, & Research titles.

 To recognize the integral part that teaching faculty have to the mission of Auburn University.

BENEFITS OF TITLE

- To align the work that many lecturers already undertake with a professor title series.
- Opportunity for endowed/sponsored professor title.

 Ability to be a Category 1 Principal Investigator along with Clinical, Extension, & Research titles.

 Title carries importance, significance, and prestige to teaching focused faculty.
