




- 49 Senators attended

### SENATOR ORIENTATION EVALUATION SUMMARY




Were you able to attend the orientation on August 15, 2024?

52 yes / 8 no


## BEST TIME FOR ORIENTATION

  - Couple of weeks after classes start




## **VALUE OF SESSIONS**






