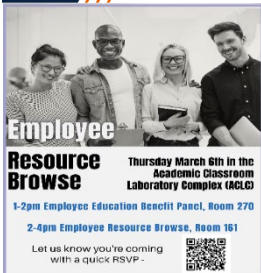
Aspire
