

Weagle Worker Eligibility

Can I be a Weagle Worker if I'm a new student?

Yes! Newly enrolled students may begin an on-campus Weagle Worker assignment as early as one week before the first day of classes.

If you need to start work earlier than this, you'll need to be hired as a Temporary (TES) employee and then transition into a Weagle Worker when the time is right.

Can I be a Weagle Worker if I am a recent Auburn graduate?

No. Following graduation, you become ineligible for Weagle Worker assignments. You aren't a student anymore!

Departments may want to continue the working relationship with their former Weagle Worker. If this is the case, the department and former student will need work through Temporary Employment Services (TES).

Can I be a Weagle Worker if I am an International Student?
