Communications Regarding Traffic and Parking Conditions Fall 2006

Notice to Vendors and Service Providers going to Haley Center or East Side of Stadium:

- Access to the Haley Center loading dock on Duncan Drive and the gates
 on the east side of the Stadium are accessible only via a <u>one-way</u>,
 <u>counter-clockwise loop</u> around the east side of the stadium created in
 conjunction with the start of construction of the new Student Center. Enter
 the one-way loop via the Donahue/Roosevelt intersection.
- Very limited standing room is available along the one-way loop, including
 the Haley Center loading dock; Tiger Transit busses and disabled persons
 have priority over the very limited amount of parking and standing room.
 Vendors and Service Providers are strongly encouraged to use small
 trucks and perform their work during off-peak times e.g. AFTER 2:00 pm
 during the week.
- Be advised that a vendor parking permit does not allow parking in loading zones. Loading zones require loading zone permits. A vendor permit only allows parking in an available space in an A, B, C, or R zone, of which there are none along the one-way circle. The nearest A, B, C or R zones to Haley Center and east gates of Stadium are in the Petrie Hall lot, Lowder Parking Lot, and the East Quad Parking Lot.
