



Coming Soon: An Enhanced Employee Long-Term Care Insurance Program

Beginning September 23, 2009, **Auburn University** will offer active employees an **enhanced Prudential Long-Term Care Insurance (LTCI) program**, issued by The Prudential Insurance Company of America. Eligible employees enrolling during the open enrollment period will be **guaranteed acceptance into the plan without providing medical history.**

“Long-term care” is help or supervision provided for someone with severe cognitive impairment or inability to perform the activities of daily living: bathing, dressing, eating, toileting, transferring, and continence. Services may be provided in a facility or at home—and care may be given by a professional or informal caregiver, such as a friend or family member.

Auburn University is making it possible for you to purchase this portable coverage at group rates. You can also extend coverage to qualified family members, such as a spouse, parent, or grandparent. (They must provide evidence of good health satisfactory to Prudential.)
