Student deferments are granted for a period of one quarter/semester at a time. If an additional quarter/semester is requested, then another Request for Deferment must be submitted OR you must request your college or university to submit certification for each quarter/semester thereafter. Graduate fellowships and graduate or post-graduate fellowship supported study are granted for a period of up to one year at a time. **DO NOT** have this form certified before student status begins. **IMPORTANT:** It is your responsibility to submit forms on time and for following up on forms; failure to do so will result in continued billings and may result in default.

Section VI. DEFINITIONS/INFORMATION

Deferment: A period during which a borrower is entitled to postpone repayment of the principal and interest payments of his/her student loan.

To qualify for a student deferment, the student must be enrolled at least half-time in an institution of higher education for the purpose of obtaining a degree or certificate.

To qualify for a deferment for study as part of a graduate fellowship program, a borrower must provide the institution certification that the borrower has been accepted for or is engaged in full-time study in the institution's graduate fellowship program.

The institution of higher education at which the borrower is enrolled does not need to be participating in the Federal Perkins Loan program for the borrower to qualify for a deferment.

If an institution no longer qualifies as an institution of higher education, the borrower's deferment ends on the date the institution ceases to qualify.

For all Federal Perkins Loans and NDSL's made on or after October 1, 1980, a borrower is also entitled to a 6-month post-deferment grace period after each student deferment.
