HOW DO I GET A TIGER CARD?

After selecting or capturing your photo, please do the following:

- 1. If needed, rotate the image so the picture is in portrait view with the subject correctly positioned.
- 2. Crop the image with full head, front view, and eyes open.
- 3. Accept the cropped selection.
- 4. Save the image file, and it will be submitted to the TigerCard office for review.

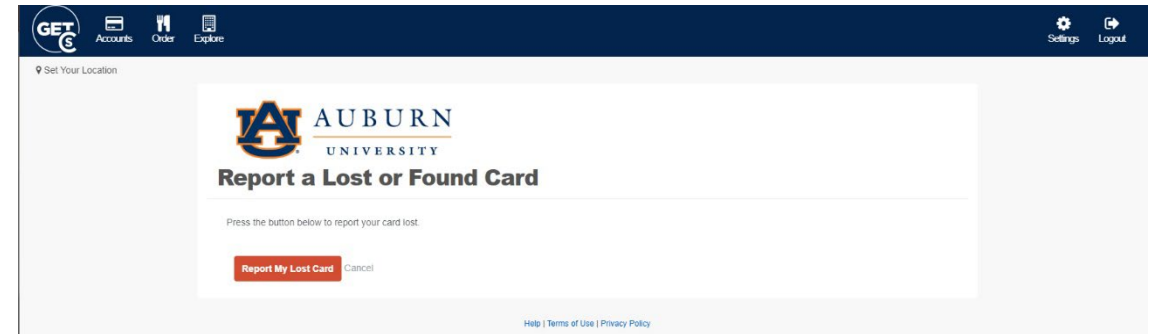

- Cost \$25 applied to eBill



HOW DO I REPLACE A LOST CARD?

- Report the Tiger Card Lost
 - Online site (get.cbord.com/auburn)
 - Tiger Card Mobile app
 - Stop by office
 - Call office
- Obtain New Card at Tiger Card Office
 - Replacements are \$25



TIGER CLUB ACCOUNT

- Voluntary, declining balance account
- Has to be set up by depositing funds
- Can be used on or off campus
- Off-campus merchants include restaurants, grocery stores, and pharmacies

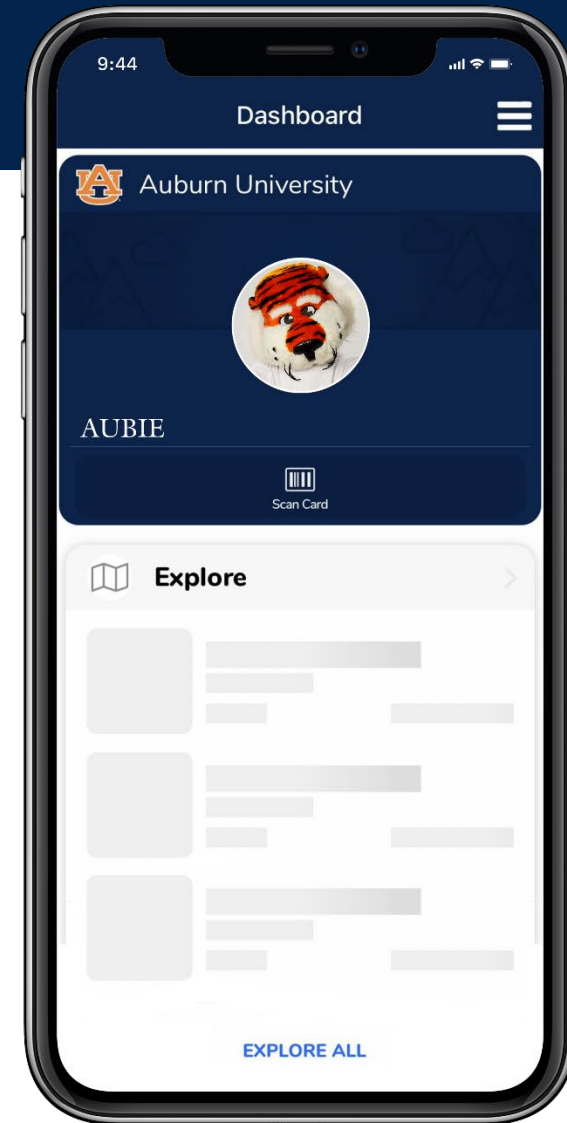


TIGER CARD MOBILE APP

- Deposit funds to the Tiger Club Account*
- Check balances on accounts*

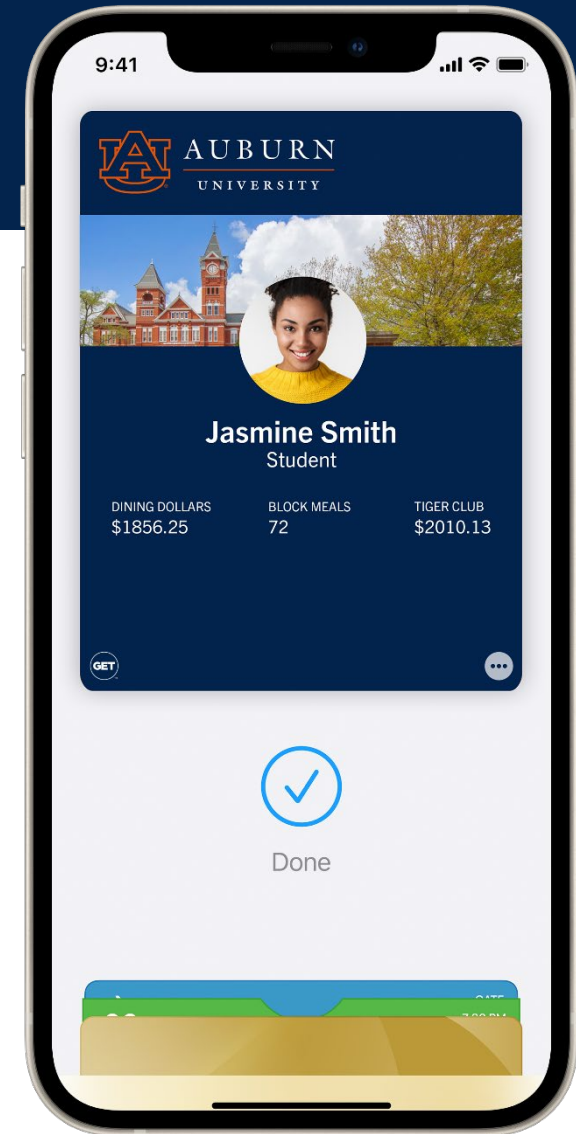


MOBILE CREDENTIAL

- Available for both Apple & Android devices
 - aub.ie/mobilecred
- Each student is only allowed to download to one device
- Must remove credential off old phone before adding to new phone
- Only accepted credential used to attend all athletic events*

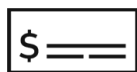

Your official student ID for campus access and privileges and optional one-card access when you link your Tiger Card¹ to a Wells Fargo checking account.

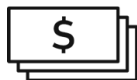

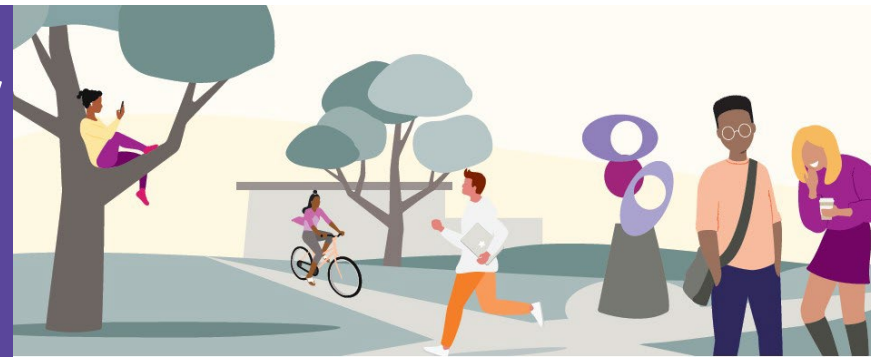
