THE AUBURN FAMILY. FEARLESS AND TRUE

Auburn University has successfully completed its Early Action review, and the upcoming final round of Early Action decisions is set to be announced on Friday, February 2, 2024. Auburn received more than 54,000 freshman applications—a 14% increase compared to the previous year. With over 12,000 resident applicants representing 100% of the counties in the state of Alabama, the demand for an Auburn education has never been greater. 39% of applicants secured admissions, with 34% hailing from Alabama. Auburn University maintains its dedication to broadening access and enhancing affordability by admitting students from all counties in the state. Additionally, 25% of the admitted students are from an underrepresented backgrounds further emphasizing the university's dedication to access. Over eight hundred were admitted through Auburn First. The 2024 admissions cycle will conclude with a regular decision release in early March.
