Auburn's Application Season in Full Swing

Auburn has received more than 20,000 freshman applications—a record increase of more than 15% compared to the previous year. With demand for an Auburn education high, the first round of early action decisions for 2024 will be announced late this week. Among the admitted students, 44% are residents of Alabama, and 15% come from underrepresented backgrounds. Additionally, 898 students gained admission through Auburn First. Early action decisions will continue to be released in mid-November and early February.
