Auburn's Application Season in Full Swing

Auburn has received more than 41,000 freshman applications—a record increase of more than 15% compared to the previous year. With demand for an Auburn education high, the next round of early action decisions for 2024 will be announced late this week. 36% have been accepted. Among the admitted students, 38% are residents of Alabama, and 20% come from underrepresented locations and backgrounds. Additionally, 898 students gained admission through Auburn First. The admissions team continues to diligently process applications, and early action decisions will continue to be released through early-February.
