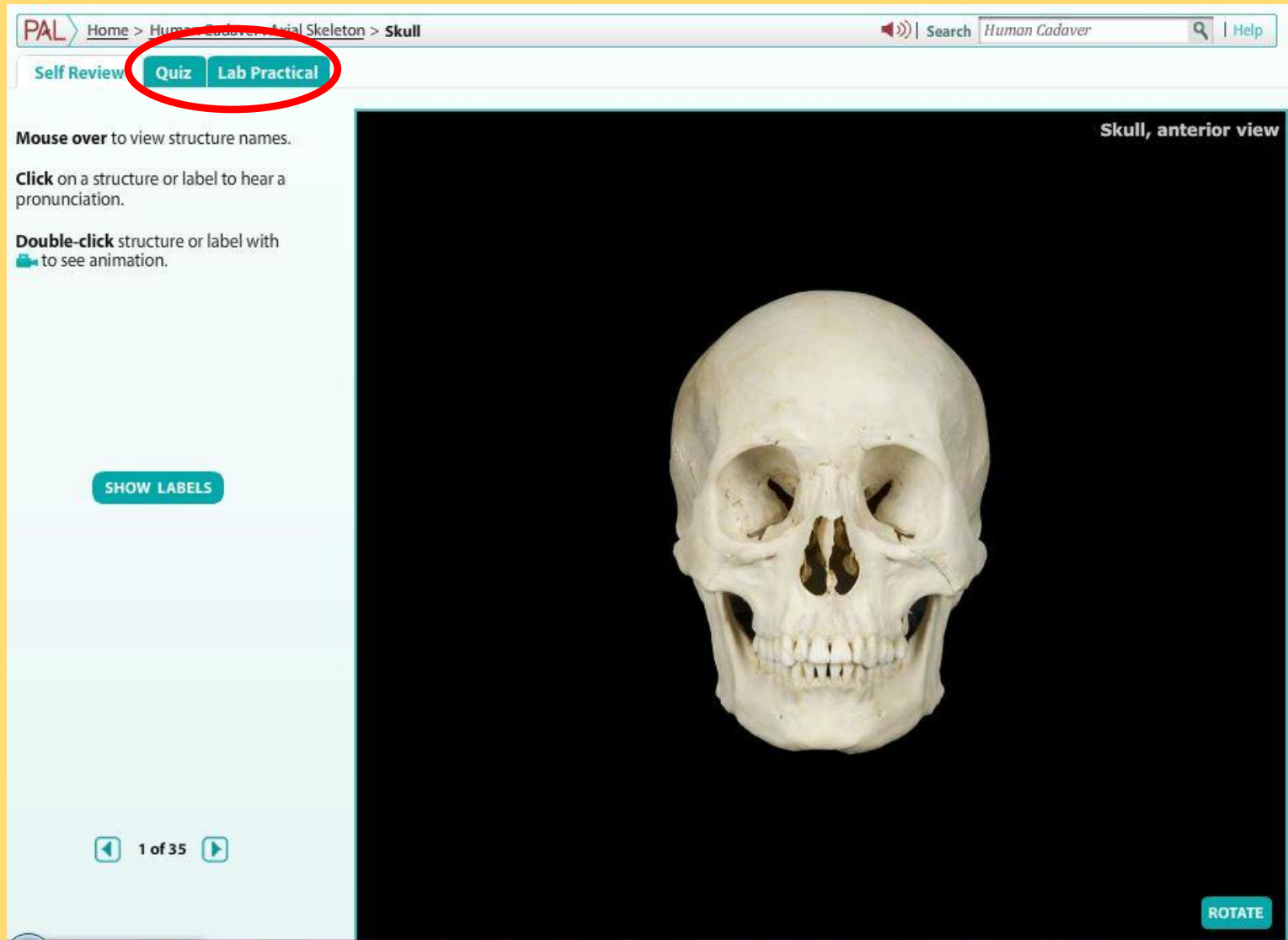
Choosing from that menu will then bring you to a group of pictures you can move through using the arrows in the bottom left

When studying, use the show/hide labels button to bring up labels. The site will highlight what you select and say it too.


