

KARATE CAMP INSTRUCTORS

Takayuki Mikami will be the lead instructor for the 35th Annual Fall Karate Training Camp. The University of South Alabama has been affiliated with Mikami and the Japan Karate Association (JKA) since 1967. The university tradition has been a dynamic base in the promotion of Shotokan Karate throughout the world.

Master Mikami, a native of Japan and a graduate of Hosei University in Tokyo, is an 8th degree black belt. He was three times All-Japan kumite (free fighting) champion and twice All-Japan kata (forms) champion. He was the first certified instructor to be sent overseas by JKA.

In 1963 he moved to the United States and in 1965, founded the All South Karate Federation (ASKF). Master Mikami is a world class karate master, referee, demonstrator and instructor.

He recently was elected senior technical advisor to the JKA and has dedicated his life to the preservation and promotion of authentic Karate-Do. He has set the goals of his organization, the JKA/American Federation and ASKF, to the highest standards of technique, the development of the character of its participants, and the fostering of the martial spirit that permeates the JKA.

For this year's camp Master Mikami invited a special guest instructor, Shoji Nishimura. Sensei Nishimura is a USA Wado-Ryu's master instructor. Wado-Ryu is one of the five major karate styles in Japan.

Nishimura is a 7th degree black belt with more than 40 years of experience. In 1977 he was the karate club captain of Rissho University in Tokyo, Japan. He has received awards for kata (forms) and kumite (free fighting) in the U.S. and Japan.



Shoji Nishimura (pictured left) has a great reputation in Kobudo applications. He has trained under specialists in self-defense and application of jujitsu techniques.

Both instructors will provide valuable information of the study and techniques that helped formalize the Kobudo system which is not your usual training, but rather a combination of modern-sports karate and the application of kumite training. This approach is geared more to application of technique instead of development of technique.

These teachings will combine the formal old style with the application of self-defense techniques.


