Women's Philanthropy Board donors are committed to inspiring, educating and enabling individuals to:

- Develop their full leadership potential
- Achieve independence as financial donors and decision-makers
- Serve as mentors for future generations of philanthropists
- Broaden the base of financial support for the College of Human Sciences

#### What is Philanthropy?

Philanthropy is the voluntary sharing of one's personal and financial resources to enhance human well-being and bring about positive change. In short, philanthropy is "Giving for a Quality Life."

### Why is it important to focus on women as philanthropists?

Women in the United States are in an unprecedented position of wealth and economic power. In fact, women now have a net worth higher than their male counterparts. Moreover, because females on average live longer than men, they will control the largest transfer of wealth from generation to generation over the next 50 years.

Historically, women have always been philanthropic in giving of their talents. Today's women are building on this traditional humanitarian role as they readily assume positions of leadership and combine their legacy of service to others with a newly discovered capacity for independent financial giving.

## How can I support the Women's Philanthropy Board?

The Women's Philanthropy Board is composed of alumni, faculty, and friends from all over the country. Philanthropic investment is open to anyone, including women and men.

WPB Visionary Donors make a minimum contribution of \$25,000 payable over a five-year period. These gifts are used to underwrite WPB's various educational and scholarship initiatives and infrastructure. Each term is renewable after five years.

WPB Legacy Donors support WPB by designating the board as a recipient of a planned gift, bequest or estate gift.

WPB Benefactor Donors pledge a minimum of \$1,000 per year for five years for a \$5,000 total pledge. A Benefactor's term is renewable after five years.

WPB Associate Donors (available for women age 30 and younger) pledge a minimum of \$500 per year for five years for a \$2,500 total pledge. An Associate donor's term is renewable after five years (subject to the age restriction.)

Throughout each academic year, WPB donors participate in educational programs and other selected forums and events.
