The application includes a short-response questionnaire.

- Students will be evaluated based on questionnaire responses, GPA, Title IX/Student Conduct standing, previous travel experience, connection to the course and/or location and the student's life/career goals. Preference will be given to students traveling abroad for the first time.
- Selected students will be notified by Friday, October 31, 2025. Alternates will also be notified on this date.
- Selected students must commit to the Study & Travel program by November 10, 2025 at 11:59 p.m.
