

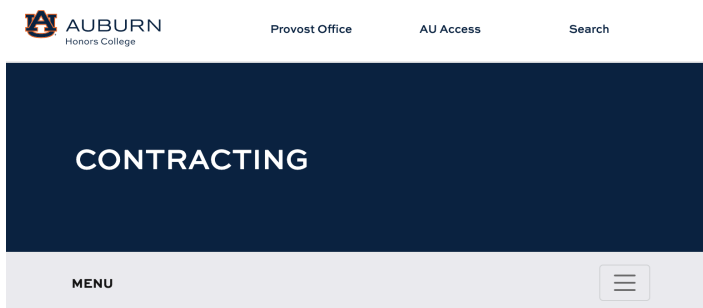
# COURSE CONTRACTS
