One official transcript of all undergraduate- and graduate-level study from each school previously attended. 3. Applicants whose native language is not English must submit the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or International English Language Testing System (IELTS). To be considered for admission, applicants must score at least 79 on the internet TOEFL (iBT), 213 on the computer TOEFL (cBT), 550 on the paper TOEFL (pBT), or 6.5 Overall Band Score on the IELTS. 4. International students must also complete a Statement of Finances Form from the Graduate School. 5. A detailed resume or curriculum vitae, to be uploaded with the online application. 6. At least three letters of recommendation from individuals who are able to speak to your ability to pursue graduate studies. 7. A Personal Statement (not to exceed two pages) that the admission committee can use to get a sense of you as a whole person. 8. Applicants have the option to submit supplementary application material that allow them to best represent themselves.
