Directions for Second Round Matching

First round match:

- Matched applicants will now have 24 hours to accept a match. Match results will be available Sunday, April 12, 2015 beginning at 6:00 pm (Central time) to both DI and DPD directors.
- On Monday, April 13, 2015, matched applicants must contact the Dietetic Internship DI Director before 6:00 PM (time zone of the program) to accept or reject their appointment.

Interim period:

- On Tuesday, April 14, 2015 starting at 12 pm (Central time), DI and DPD directors will have access to the non-matched applicant list on D&D Digital.
- DI directors may invite students they previously ranked who were not matched to their program. During this period, once the notification period is over, DI directors with available openings will be allowed time to invite unmatched applicants they originally entered on the list submitted to D&D Digital to attend their program.

Second Round Selection Period:

On Thursday, April 16, 2015 at 11 am (central time), non-matched applicants will have access to the list of DI programs with openings. This program list will include ISPPs. **This list will include the Auburn University M.S. in Nutrition Non-Thesis Option ISPP Experience!**

- On Wednesday, April 22, 2015 at 12 pm (central time), applications are due on DICAS.
- On Thursday, April 23, 2015 at 11 am (central time), DI directors **(and ISPP directors)** of all programs may begin to invite applicants into their programs.

Monday after Match 6 pm (time zone of program)	Applicants notify DI Directors of their acceptance or withdrawal from the program.

Tuesday after match day 12:01 pm (CST)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> DI Directors and DPD Directors have access to the “match/no-match” list on D&D Digital; DI directors with openings have the option to contact and invite any of their original qualified applicants on the “unmatched” list to attend their programs. DPD Directors should alert students to the possibility of being contacted between 12:01 p.m. (CST) Tuesday and 8:00 p.m. (CST) Wednesday and being offered a spot. DPD Directors should communicate to their students the importance of accepting a position offered to them during the interim period and not back out of an accepted position if
Wednesday after match day 8 pm (CST)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> DI Directors who have filled their open spots will update their “open” status to “closed” on D&D Digital. DI Directors will send an e-mail to D&D Digital notifying them of their closed status and provide the name and e-mail of the applicant(s) who filled the open spot(s). Thursday after match day 11:00 am (CST)	The “match/non-matched” list and DI programs with open spots are made available to all stakeholders (This will include the AU MS in Nutrition with ISPP Experience.)
Wednesday, Ten days after match Day 12 noon (CST)	Second round applications are due on DICAS by 12 noon. (Please submit your Auburn Application through DICAS.)
Thursday, Eleven days after Match Day 11:00 am (CST)	DI and ISPP Directors may begin inviting applicants into their DI programs after 11:00 am (CST).

For those accepted into the Auburn MS in Nutrition with ISPP Experience, a formal application will need to be submitted to the graduate school by May 20th (preferably earlier).
